Monthly Meeting — March 3, 2011**

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m.

**Treasurer's Report:** Marty passed out a treasurer's report. He commented on the high heating oil bills, which were over \$3,000 for the month of February (although a couple of bills paid were for oil delivered in January).

**Correspondence:** Paul got a notice from the EPA about non-compliance about not having a third-party inspection of the gas hose. This will be referred to Dave Greenwood. There was an invitation to the UMass Boston Community Breakfast; Ray will answer the invitation. We sent \$250.00 for our MBYCA membership and another \$850.00 for the booster book.

**House:** No report.

**Inboard Floats:** Al has set dates with Dan Campbell's office manager to build floats. We should check with Al to get the dates and send them out to the membership and include in the newsletter.

**Outboard:** Bob has called a few guys about floats that need repair, and has written up a cost sheet for rebuilt finger floats. Bob is still having problems with some of the outlets on the outboard

**Regatta:** Jack Lewis said we'll need another refrigerator for the club. Dan Campbell said he had a spare at the shop and Jack should send someone to pick it up. Jack also said we should get another propane grill. Another need is for electricity on the deck, either getting more extension cords with gang boxes for parties or having power run to outlets around the deck. Jack also suggested we get some spotlights on the deck; Bob Mirabito said there should be lights on the flags anyway since they are being flown 24/7.

Jack also suggested that we get a tent for the deck, which could be put where we have a band set up in the corner by the stairs. Suggestions made were to check the party store at the Avon Industrial Park.

Jack finally suggested we get a better sound system. He's talked with a couple of places, and has recommendations for a system with an amp, switch box for speakers, etc. from MHL in Randolph. The proposal would include assembling the equipment and then we

would install. Ray suggested this would have to be secure (in a locked, mounted box) and have a timer so the system would be shut down after 11 pm. The proposal includes four sets of speakers (\$400) and an iPod dock, a receiver (\$500), a switcher (\$500) and stereo wires) \$3126.00 (tax included).

Opening Day will be June 18, from noon to . Charge is \$15.00. There will be a live band (same as last year), a bounce tent for the kids, cookout food, etc. Jack would like to have the blessing of the fleet on the same day.

**Safety:** No report.

**New Business:**

Ray Tomasini reported that Chris Busch oversees our permit that allows us to do work and maintenance of the club (required for work done over a waterway). Ray will be meeting with him to update our 5-year permit.

Marty said we will need a new gas dispenser (pump) as the one we have no longer measures the fuel dispensed.

It was agreed that we would meet at 6:00 p.m. for future BOD meetings.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:41 p.m.

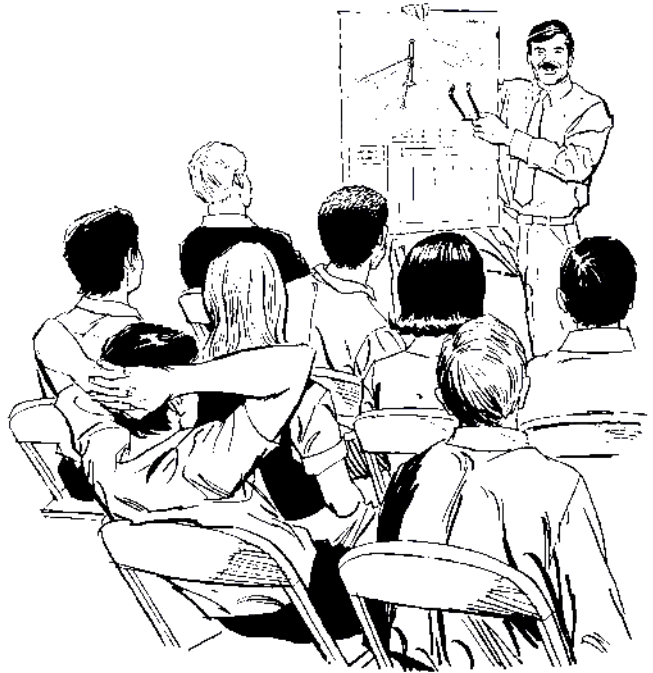
